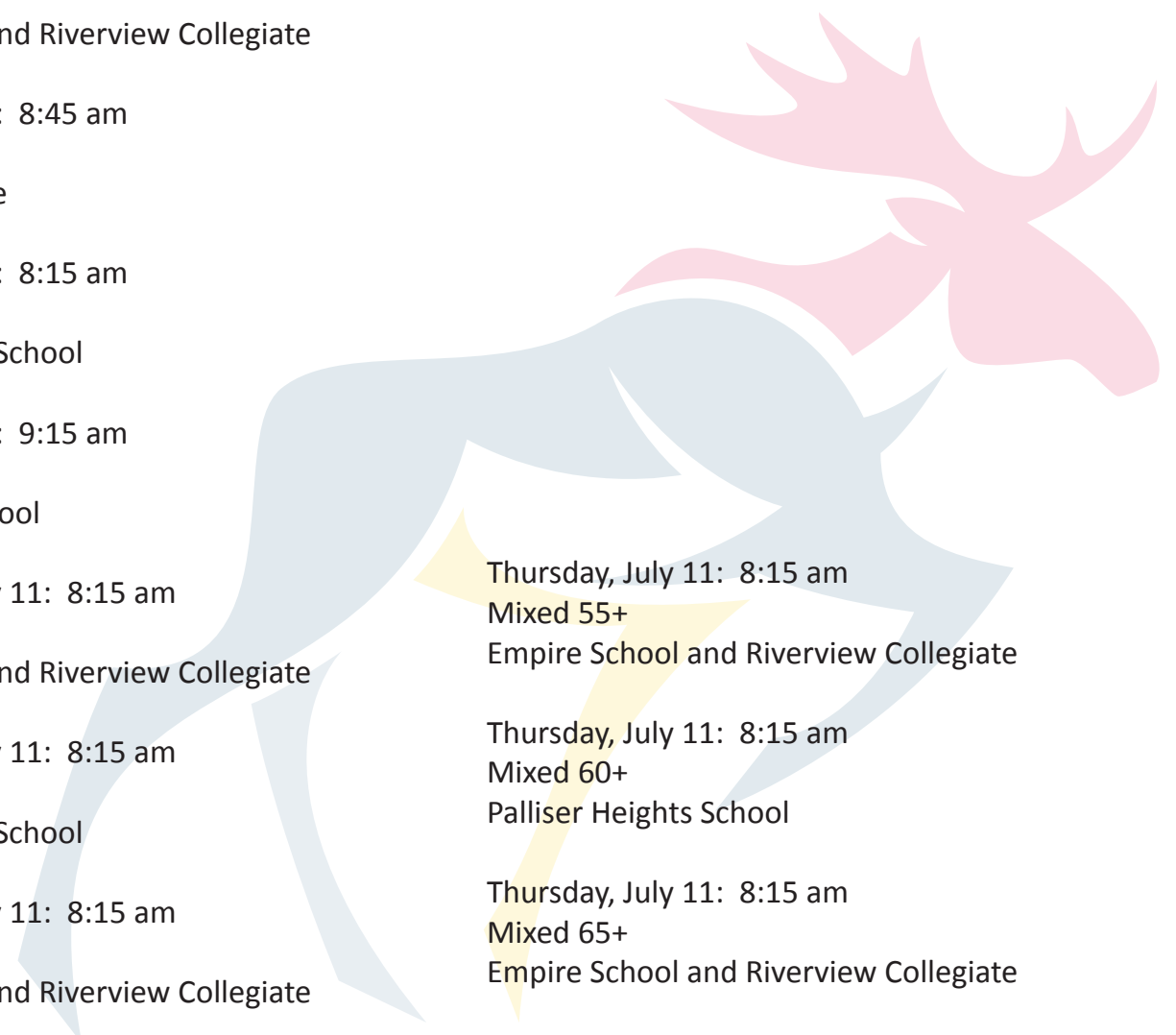

Pickleball Tournament Rules

(USAPA -2018 Official Tournament Rule Book)

Men's Doubles; Women's Doubles; Mixed Doubles

Game Format

Men's/Women's Doubles will be round robin format with pools for larger groups of teams. Each draw will indicate the number of teams to advance to medal round. Play will be to 21 points with a win differential of 2 points. Only medal games will be best 2 out of 3. Games will be to 11 points with win differential of 2 points.

Mixed doubles will be double elimination format with best 2 out of 3 games, to 11 points with win differential of 2 points. If winner of loser bracket defeats the winner of the winner's bracket, then a tie breaker to 15 points will be played.

Exception

Mixed 70 plus and 75 plus – All games will be best 2 out of 3, to 11 points, win by 2 points. For round robin games, if 2 or more teams are tied,

- First tie-breaker – head to head
- Second tie-breaker – point differential of all games player. (12.C.3.)
- If still tied, coin toss

All team are required to be ready to play 15 minutes prior to scheduled game time. If not ready to play at scheduled time, the result will be a game loss. Winners of each game are required to report score to tournament coordinator or designate after game completed.

All teams are responsible to check posted schedule to ensure they are at the correct time and place for each match. If any change is made in posted schedule after initial posting, the tournament director or designate shall notify players.

Time Outs

A team is allowed two time outs per 11 or 21 point game.

Each time out may last up to 1 minute (10.A.2.)

Hydration time outs are not allowed

Equipment time outs are not allowed

Medical time outs (10.B.)

Time between each game in a match shall not exceed 2 minutes. (10.D.)

The minimum time between matches shall be 10 minutes, unless all players are ready to play prior to 10 minutes, then the match may be called early.

Extra Game in Double Elimination Draws (10.E.1.)

Player Duties and Line Calls (13.D.)

Only line judges will be provided for gold/silver medal games.
